## An Introduction

## Teaching Faculty

## Entry Requirements

### Diploma:

Minimum 5 credits in SPM Certificate including:

- Bahasa Malaysia,
- Mathematics (Elementary or Additional or Modern)
- Either one (1) of the credits below:
  - General Science
  - Biology
  - Chemistry and Pass in Biology
  - Physics and Pass in Biology
- Pass in English

STPM Certificate holders are encouraged to apply.

### Assistant Nurse:

SPM Certificate with at least 2 credits including Bahasa Malaysia and must pass in General Science or Biology, Mathematics (Elementary or Additional or Modern), and English.

## Programmes

The 3-year Diploma in Nursing Programme and 2-year Assistant Nurse Programme are both fully accredited by the Board of Nursing Malaysia and MQA (Malaysian Qualification Agency), and approved by the Ministry of Education. Students are taught a wide range of subjects in Basic Sciences, Nursing Sciences and Behavioural Sciences.
